Chapter 98

98. Amusement Devices and Music Machines

- 98.010 License Required. No amusement device or music machine shall be operated in the City without the owner or operator first obtaining a license therefore and paying the fee in accordance with Chapter 90. The owner or operator of each device or machine must secure a license known as an "operator's license" which operator's license shall entitle the holder thereof to operate two (2) devices or machines. However, for the third such device or machine thereafter which is operated by the licensed owner or operator, a separate license for each such device or machine shall be required.
- 98.020 Definition. For the purposes of this chapter:
- (1) An amusement device shall be any game, machine or device that requires the payment of money to play the game or operate the machine or device, and which is operated so as to possibly reward the player or operator with additional games or operations without additional payment of money.
 - (2) A music machine, including a so-called "juke box" shall be any machine or device that requires the payment of money into a device or machine for the playing of music or songs.
